### **Congressional Nomination Process**

Admission to a U.S. service academy is a two-tiered process. **First**, the candidate must **apply for admission** and meet the high entry standards set by the individual academy. These standards include, among others, medical, physical and scholastic qualifications. The **second** tier is to **obtain a nomination from an official source**. An individual must meet the admission requirements of the academy, as well as, receive a nomination in order to be considered for appointment to the academies.

To be considered for an appointment to a U.S. service academy, an applicant must have a nomination from an authorized nomination source. There are two nomination categories. The first, usually referred to as "congressional nominations" include nominations from the applicant's U.S. Senators (Senator John Cornyn: <a href="www.cornyn.senate.gov">www.cornyn.senate.gov</a>), (Senator Ted Cruz: <a href="www.cruz.senate.gov">www.cruz.senate.gov</a>), and from the applicant's U.S. Representative (U.S. Congressman Tony Gonzales: <a href="https://gonzales.house.gov">https://gonzales.house.gov</a>). Applicants to a Senator's office must be residents of the State of Texas; applicants to House offices must be residents of that congressional district. <a href="Note">Note</a>: Each member of Congress is permitted to nominate up to 10 individuals from his or her district/state for each academy.

Also, included in this nomination category is the Vice President of the United States (https://www.whitehouse.gov/service-academy-nominations). Vice President submission deadline is January 31<sup>st</sup>. Note: The Vice President may NOT nominate to Coast Guard or Merchant Marine Academies.

The second nomination category is referred to as "service-connected" or "military-affiliated" nominations. Children of career and/or retired military personnel may also seek a nomination through the Office of the President of the United States (see academy websites for more details).

As the nomination process is highly competitive, it is strongly recommended that interested students pursue nominations from all the nominating sources available to them and apply for admission to all academies in which they have a sincere interest.

Congressman Gonzales' nomination functions as a recommendation to the academies, and it is his responsibility to nominate highly qualified and committed candidates to each academy. Assisting him in the nominations process is his Service Academy Board. The Board will meet in November to perform an objective, merit-based review of the applicants' files and conduct personal interviews. Congressman Gonzales' office will notify qualified applicants of their interview status in late October/early November. Congressman Gonzales' nominees will be presented to the academies in January for appointment consideration. A congressional nomination does not guarantee acceptance to the academies. Ultimate selection of appointees rests solely with academy officials and is based on their competitive evaluation of all nominees.

### **Timetable for the Nomination Application Process**

#### **Application Process Opens**

Students, who reside in the 23<sup>rd</sup> Congressional District of Texas and meet the eligibility criteria, may request a Congressional Nomination to a Service Academy. You may request Congressman Gonzales' nomination packet at any time up to the submission deadline. However, the earlier you begin the process of applying and gathering the required documents, the better.

## October 30, 2025: Nomination Application Deadline

ALL nomination packets and required documents MUST be postmarked by 11: 59 PM on October 30<sup>th</sup>, 2025. NO EXCEPTIONS. Send completed nomination packets to:

Applicants are responsible for making sure their files are complete. If you do not submit the required documentation by the above deadline, your application will not be considered. You will be notified by Congressman Gonzales' office when your file is complete. Note: Applicants are strongly encouraged to contact Congressman Gonzales' San Antonio office to set-up an appointment with staff to review your completed application packet ahead of the deadline so that any problems may be addressed early.

#### **TBD November 2025: Interviews with Academy Board**

Congressman Gonzales' Service Academy Board will meet in November to perform an objective, merit-based review of qualified applicants' files and to conduct personal interviews. Notification of interview appointment date, time and place will be made to qualified applicants.

#### January 2026: Announcement of Nominees

All candidates will be notified as to their nomination status and nominations submitted to the Service Academies.

#### **Eligibility Requirements**

Applicants must meet the following requirements as of July 1 of the year of admission to the Academy:

Age: The student must be between 17 and 22 years of age. (USMMA: 25 years of age)

**Citizenship:** Applicant must be a United States Citizen by November 1 of the application year.

**Marital Status:** Must be unmarried, not pregnant and have no legal obligation to support children or other dependents.

**Domicile:** Candidate must reside in the 23<sup>rd</sup> Congressional District of Texas

#### Selection Criteria

Nominations from U.S. Congressman Tony Gonzales are based on an evaluation process that examines all aspects of an applicant's qualifications. Applicants are considered for nomination based upon four criteria:

**Scholarship:** Evaluation of academic records will include the applicant's grade point average, SAT/ACT scores, student's willingness to embrace academic challenges, and, if applicable, any college records.

**Leadership:** Consideration will be made based on the student's leadership experience and potential command ability. The consideration of this qualification will be based upon the applicant's record of extracurricular activities. Quality of involvement is stressed over the number of activities.

**Character/Motivation:** Consideration of the motivation and desire of applicants to attend a service academy is based upon the essay submitted by the applicant, their recommendations and evaluation forms, and their interview before the Academy Board.

**Competitiveness:** The final consideration of an applicant for a nomination is comparative in nature, appraising each applicant's attributes against all others who are applying.

Note: With respect to the congressional nomination category, each Representative and each Senator is allowed to have at each academy five persons at any one time charged to his or her quota. There are three methods of congressional nomination; Congressman Gonzales utilizes the "competitive method".

Using this method, the Member of Congress (MOC) submits an unranked slate of nominees for each vacancy at each academy. For each open vacancy, usually one per year at each academy, up to ten nominations may be made. The competitive method provides that the nominees on each slate compete among themselves for appointment consideration by the admissions authorities at that academy. Each academy reviews the submitted slate for that specific academy and selects the most qualified nominee(s) for appointment.

Appointment offers rest solely with each academy. As a courtesy to the Member of Congress (MOC) who submitted the nomination, each academy will notify the MOC of an appointment offer that will be extended to one of their nominees. The MOC then has the opportunity to notify their constituent of the appointment offer.

An appointment to the U.S. Military Academy, U.S. Naval Academy, U.S. Air Force Academy, or U.S. Merchant Marine Academy is a distinct and rare honor. Acceptance of an academy appointment requires at least a nine-year service obligation, including four years at an academy and five years of active duty service.

### Admission to a U.S. Service Academy

In addition to seeking and obtaining a nomination from an official source, it is also necessary for the applicant to directly contact the Academy(s) of their choice to initiate a pre-candidate file. Candidates are evaluated for admission on the basis of outstanding academic performance (high school record and SAT or ACT scores), demonstrated leadership potential, physical aptitude, and medical qualification.

Each service academy will be able to answer specific questions and schedule individual medical examinations. Note: Such examinations are separate from the nomination process and are required prior to receiving an appointment to a service academy. Due to the rigorous physical programs at the academies, candidates must meet the medical and physical requirements specified by each academy to which they seek admittance.

Remember that the congressional nomination process and the academy application process are different and separate. To apply for admission to an academy and obtain more information:

Submit your completed application as a total packet, including all items in a single packet postmarked or delivered to the San Antonio District Office by October 30th, 2025.

Application completed and signed by applicant and parent(s)/guardian(s). Application must be completed by the applicant ONLY and <b>must be typed</b> . (Request a fill-in PDF version from Congressman Gonzales' San Antonio office.) If additional space is needed to complete an application section, add additional paper. Requested information MUST BE included on the application; a resume IS NOT a substitute.
(NOTE: If applicant presently resides outside of the Congressional District of Texas, you must submit at least two items of documentary evidence of your 23rd District residency. Parent(s) must hold a current driver's license and/or voter registration listing an address in the 23rd District. If parents are divorced, legal domicile is determined by the parent who has legal custody.)
<u>Current COLOR <b>photograph</b></u> (No larger than 4"x5") with your name printed on the back. Staple photo to the upper right-hand corner of the first page of the application. NO "selfies" allowed.
Complete attached cover letter with all requested information.
A typed (double-spaced in 12-point Arial or Times New Roman font), well-written 500-word <b>essay</b> regarding: What does leadership mean you? Describe a time that you demonstrated your own leadership.
Personal Evaluation Forms & Letters of Recommendation (3) A completed Personal Evaluation Form MUST accompany each Letter of Recommendation. Do not send more than the required three. Recommendations should be from individuals unrelated to you, who know you personally, who can assess your intellect, character, motivation and suitability for military service. One must be from a teacher, coach, principal or guidance counselor. The other two references are at the applicant's discretion. However, if applicant is attending a prep school or on active military duty, one of these letters must be from a Commanding Officer. No handwritten letters will be accepted.
Those individuals providing a Letter of Recommendation and completing a <i>Personal Evaluation Form</i> should place them together into an envelope, seal and write their signature across the envelope flap. Request them to return the sealed envelope to you for inclusion in your application packet. (NOTE: References can be one of the chief causes of delays in completing an application packet. Build in ample time for your recommenders to complete and return the documents to you in a timely manner.)
Official, sealed copy of your <b>high school transcript</b> that includes your calculated GPA, numerical rank (position in class), and class size after completion of your junior year. For graduates, must show graduation date. (NOTE: If your school does not rank students, you must

have the counselor or principal note this on your transcript.) Your school may mail the transcript directly to Congressman Gonzales' San Antonio office.

Official, sealed copy of your **college transcript** (if applicable) including courses currently in progress and GPA.

At least one official **SAT or ACT** score record; must be postmarked to Congressman Gonzales' San Antonio office by October 30, 2025 Include at least one of the following:

- -Direct report(s) from the testing agency, OR
- -Score listing(s) on your official transcript, OR
- -Print-outs from the official SAT and/or ACT websites included with your completed application packet

#### Congressman Gonzales' score report codes are: SAT: 5452, ACT: 7704.

Carefully consider the dates that you are taking these tests; if you wait until September to take a test for the first time, your scores may not arrive by the October 30, 2025 submission deadline. Tests taken in September may not be considered unless they are an additional and updated score report. We will accept updated test results past the October 30, 2025 deadline, provided that you have previously submitted test scores by the deadline.(NOTE: Applicant must have a minimum 1050 SAT score or its corresponding equivalent on the ACT for application to be considered for review by Congressman Gonzales' Academy Board.)

**Candidate file** must be opened by **October 1**, **2025** at each of one the Service Academies you list as a preference.
